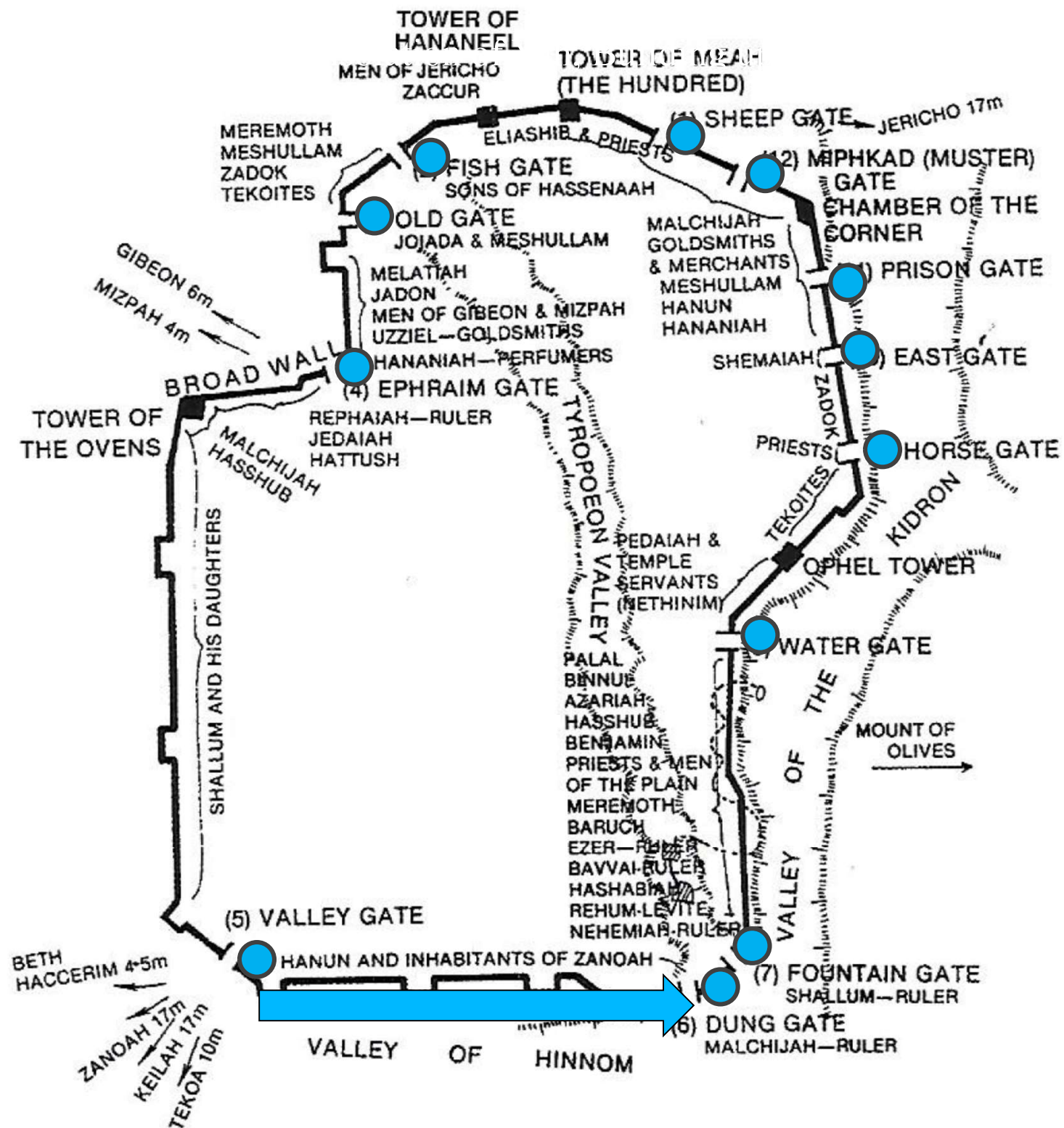

(Jer. 19:1-3).

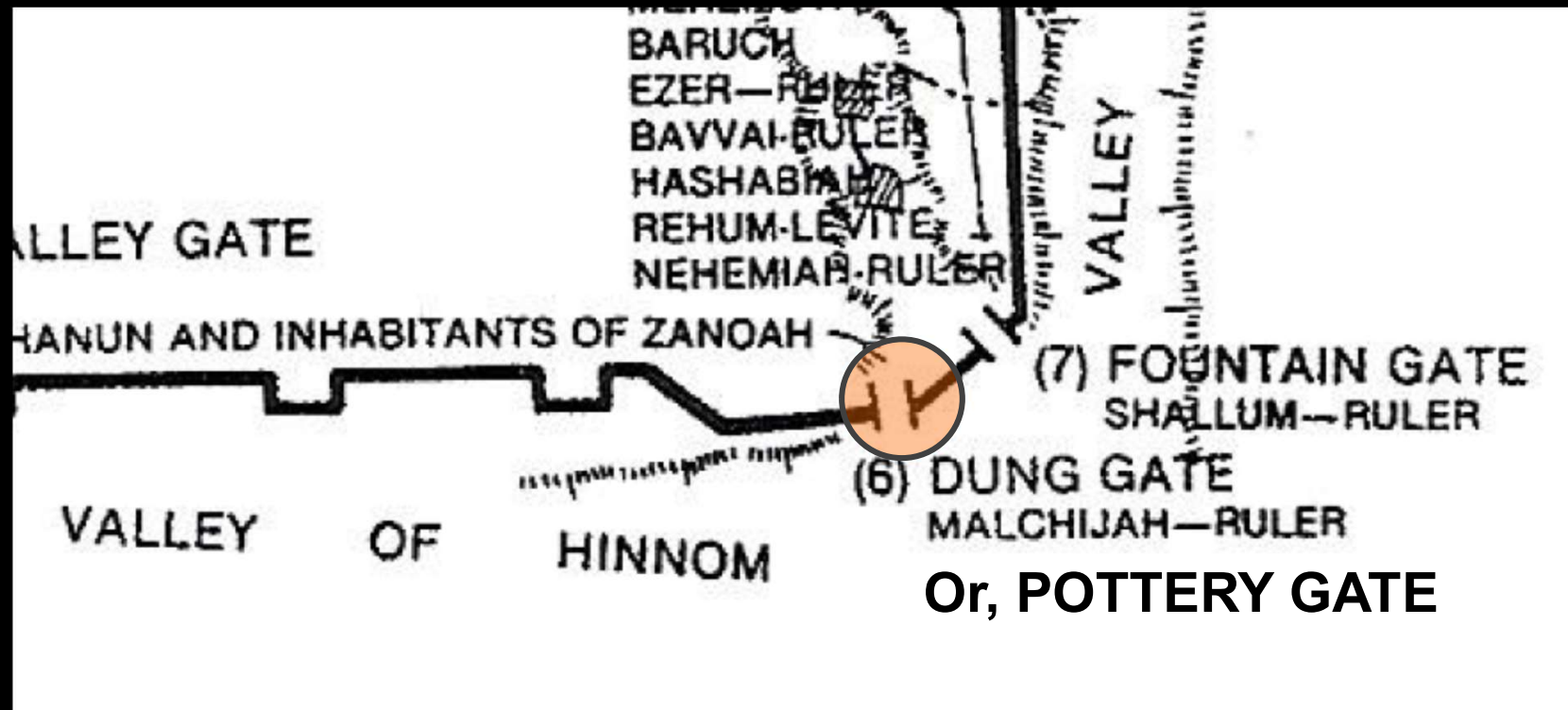
Jer 19:1 Thus saith the LORD, Go and get a potter's earthen bottle, and take of the ancients of the people, and of the ancients of the priests;

*Jer 19:2 **And go forth unto the valley of the son of Hinnom, which is by the entry of the east gate**, and proclaim there the words that I shall tell thee,*

Jer 19:3 And say, Hear ye the word of the LORD, O kings of Judah, and inhabitants of Jerusalem; Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will bring evil upon this place, the which whosoever heareth, his ears shall tingle...

The Hebrew word translated “east” in verse 2 is carsuth, which means **“a potsherd”** which the historian Gesenius identifies as ***the pottery gate.***”

Zec 11:12-13 *And I said unto them, If ye think good, give me my price; and if not, forbear. So they weighed for my price thirty pieces of silver. And the LORD said unto me, Cast it unto the potter: a goodly price that I was prised at of them. And I took the thirty pieces of silver, and cast them to the potter in the house of the LORD.*

Mat 27:7-9 *(7) And they took counsel, and bought with them the potter's field, to bury strangers in. (8) Wherefore that field was called, The field of blood, unto this day. (9) Then was fulfilled that which was spoken by Jeremy the prophet...*

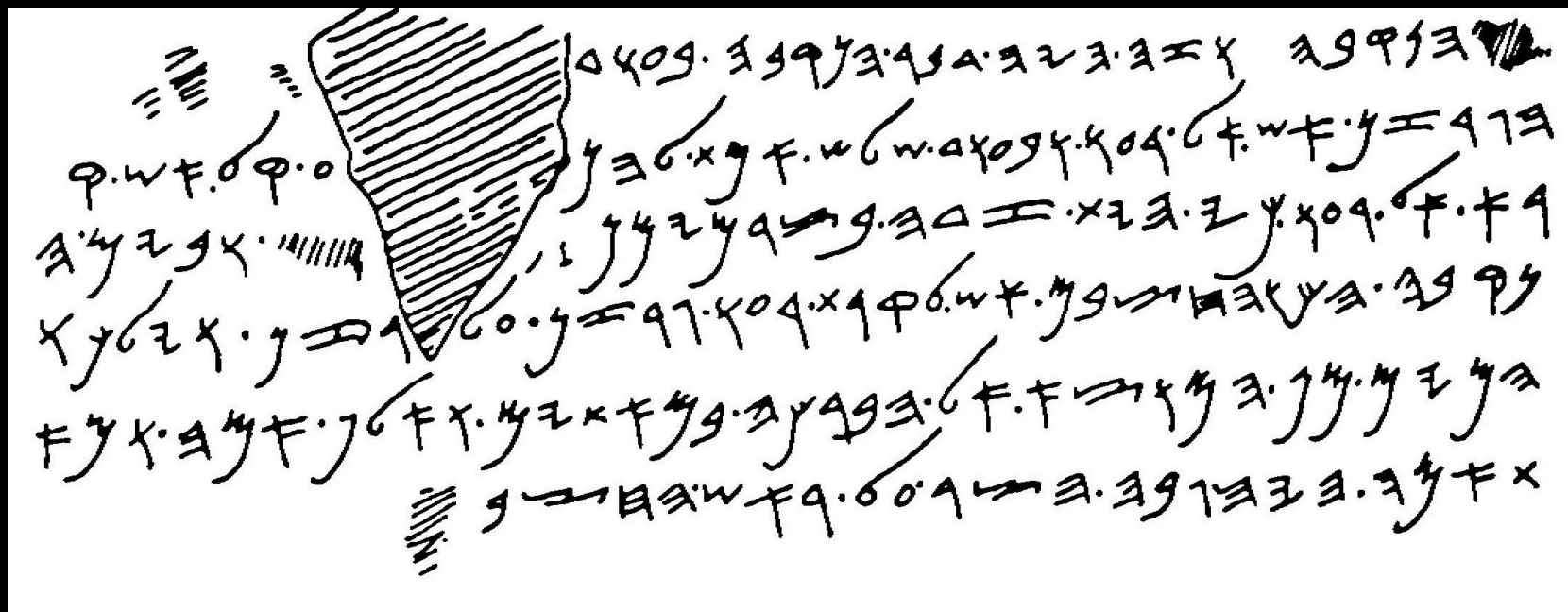
Fountain Gate

(Gehenna)

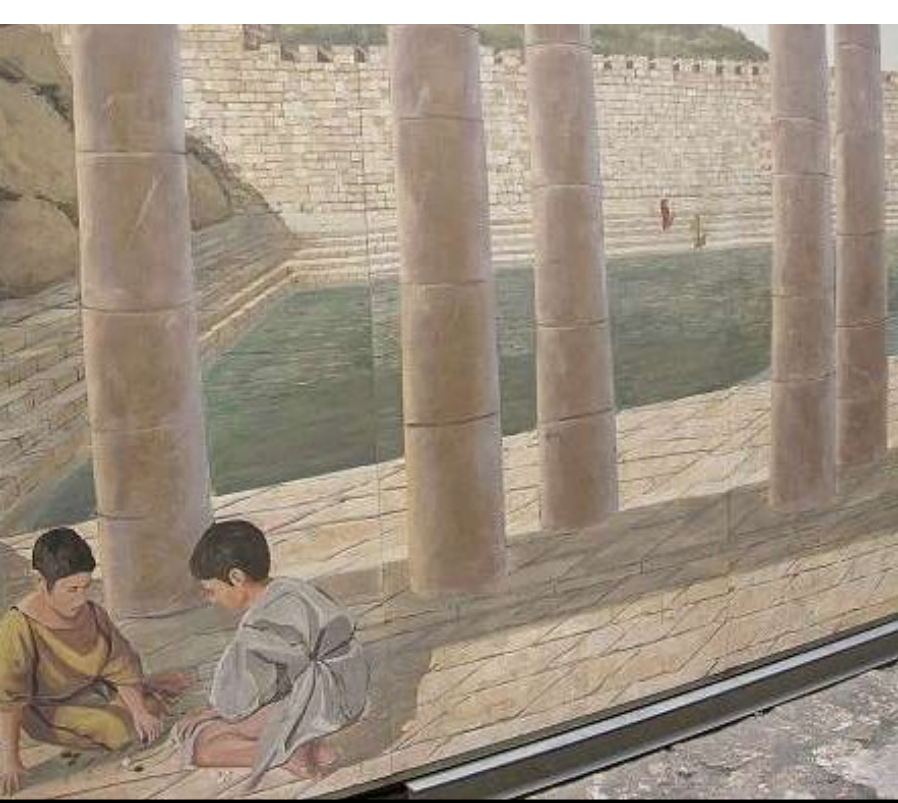

“[...when] (the tunnel) was driven through. And this was the way in which it was cut through: While [...] (were) still [...] axe(s), each man toward his fellow, and while there were still three cubits to be cut through, [there was heard] the voice of a man calling to his fellows, for there was an overlap in the rock on the right [and on the left]. And when the tunnel was driven through, the quarrymen hewed (the rock), each man toward his fellow, axe against axe; and the water flowed from the spring toward the reservoir for 1200 cubits, and the height of the rock above the head(s) of the quarrymen was 100 cubits.”



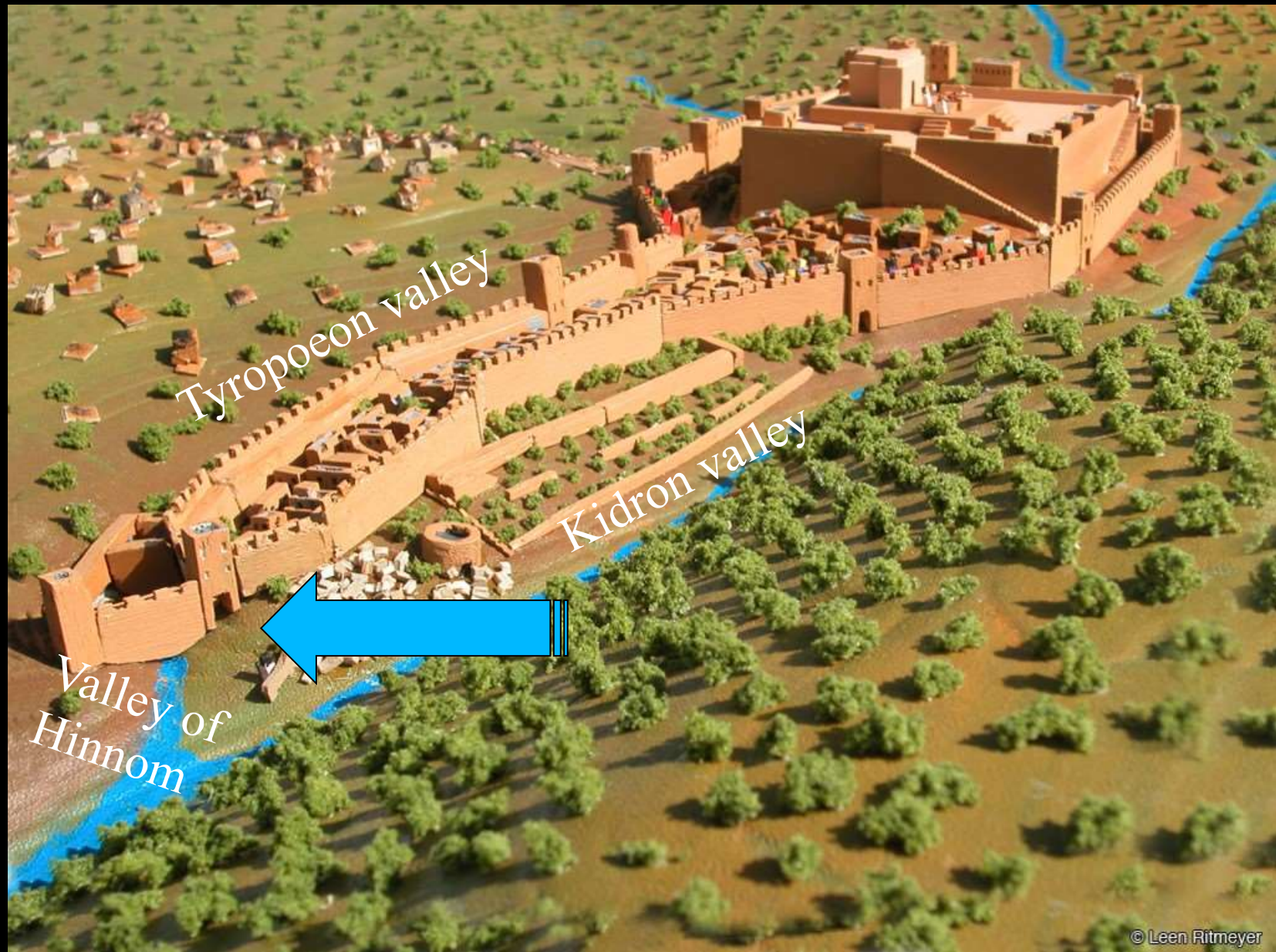

Joh 7:28-29 *Then cried Jesus in the temple as he taught, saying, Ye both know me, and ye know whence I am: and I am not come of myself, but he that sent me is true, whom ye know not. (29) But I know him: **for I am from him, and he hath sent me.***

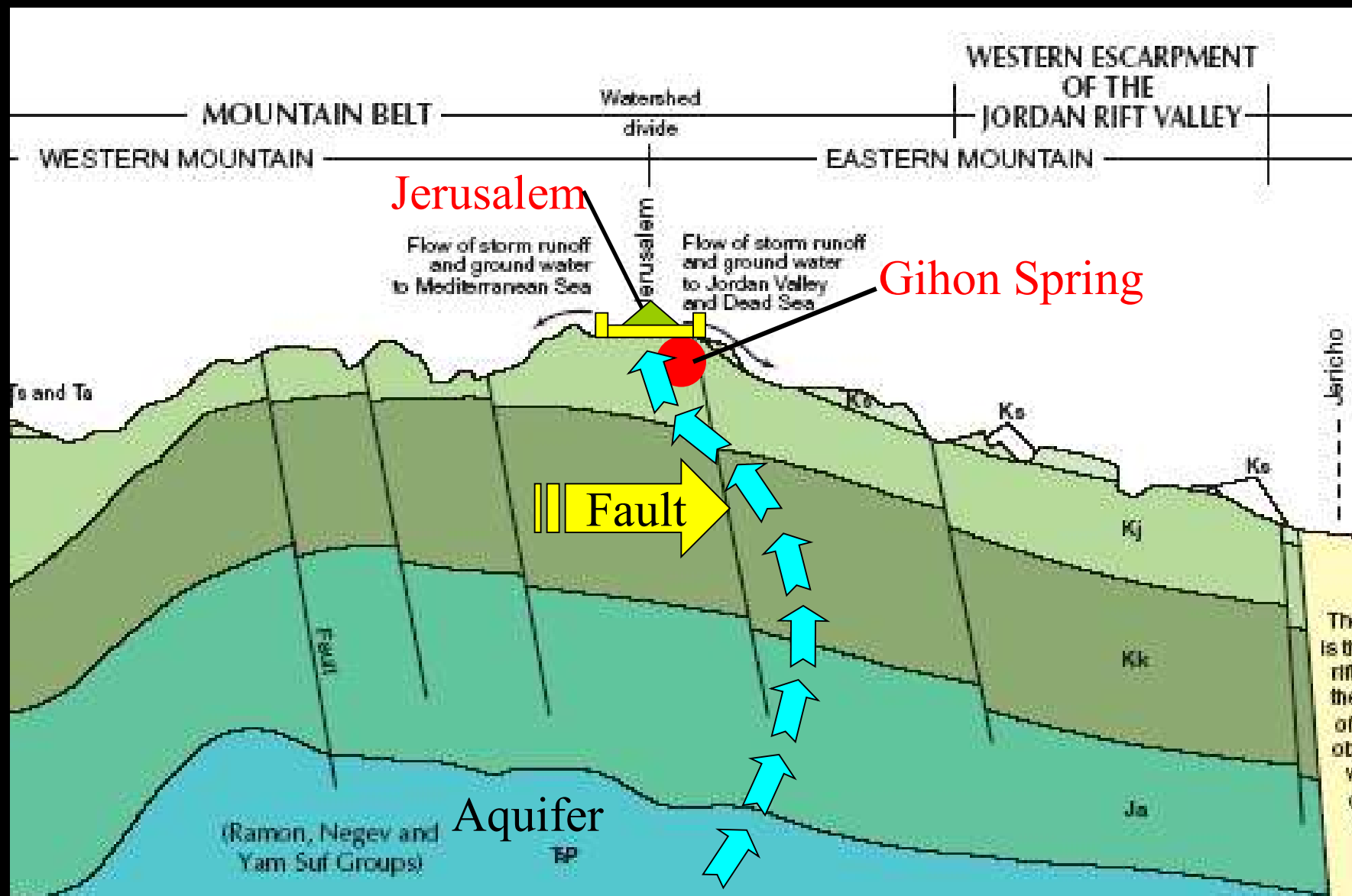
Joh 7:37-38 *In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, **If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.** (38) He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, **out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.***

1Co 10:4 *And did all drink the same spiritual drink: **for they drank of that spiritual Rock** that followed them: and that Rock was Christ.*
