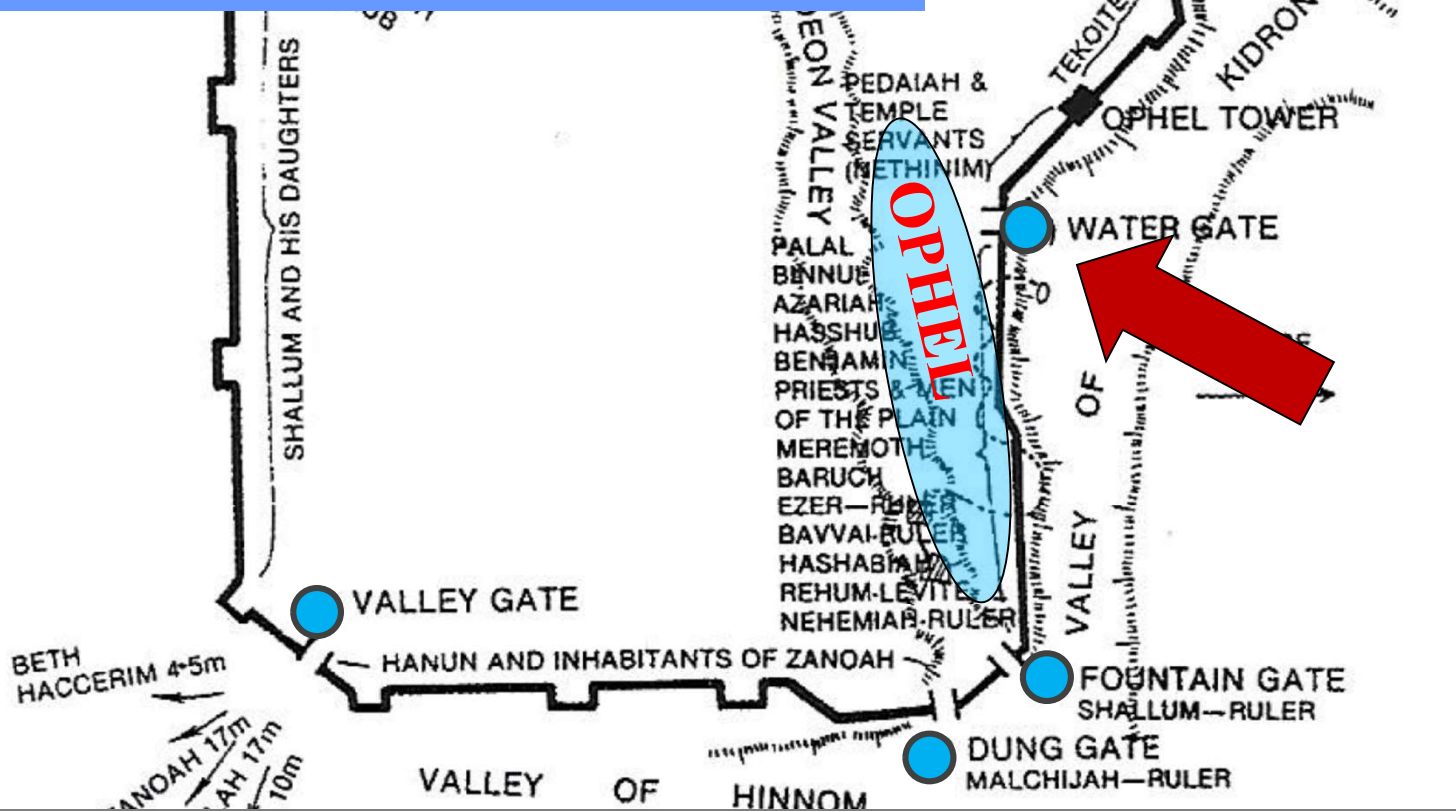

Nethinim = Dedicated, or Given
Ophel = Fortified or Strong Hold

(Ezra 8:20; Psa. 51:2-7; Eph. 5:26)

(27) After them the Tekoites repaired another piece, over against the great tower that lieth out, even unto the wall of Ophel.

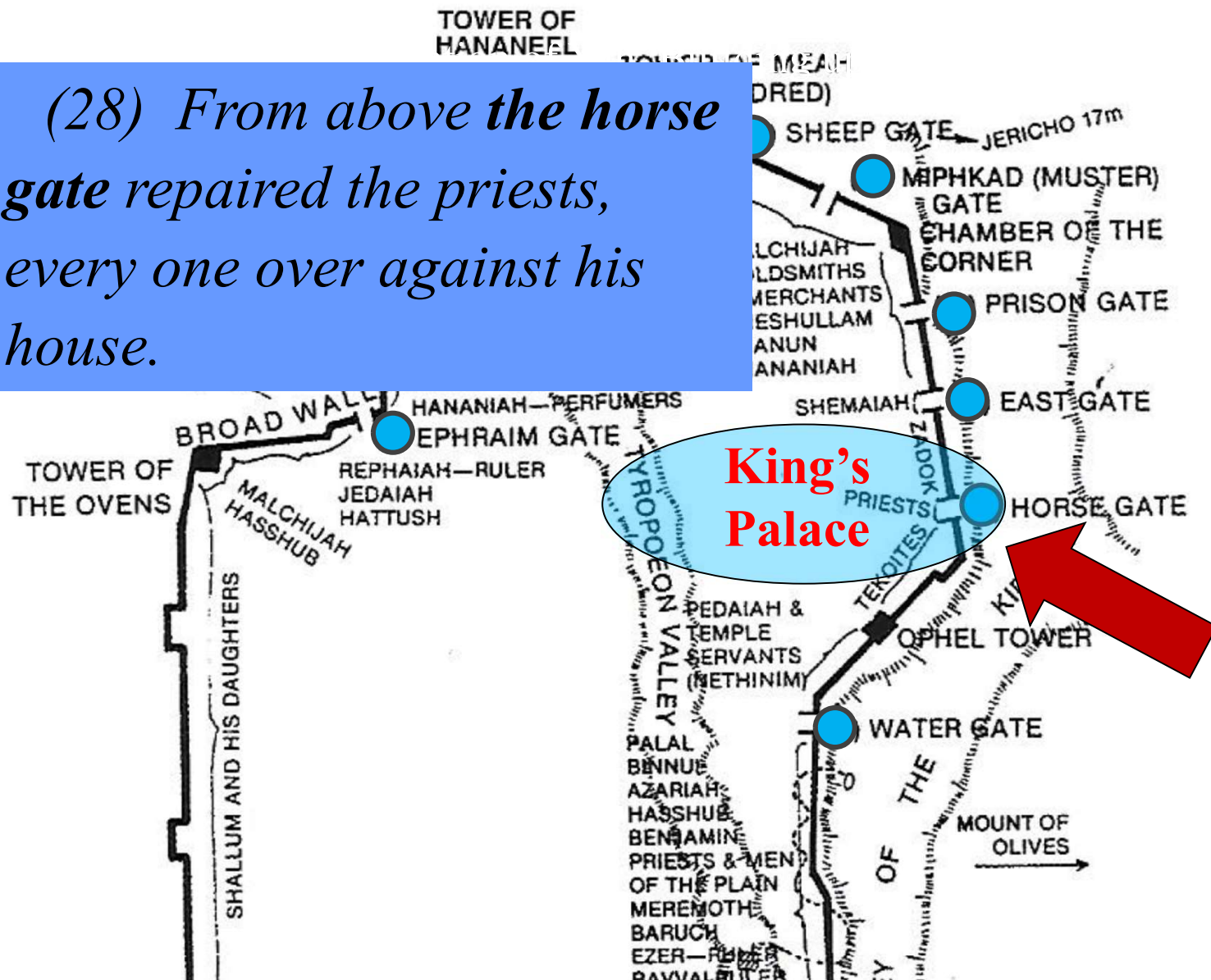
Tekoites = Root, A Trumpet

(Psa. 47:5; Psa. 98:6; James 1:22-24)

(28) From above the horse gate repaired the priests, every one over against his house.

(Song 1:9; Hab. 3:13-15; Zech. 6:1-5; Rev. 19:1, 14).

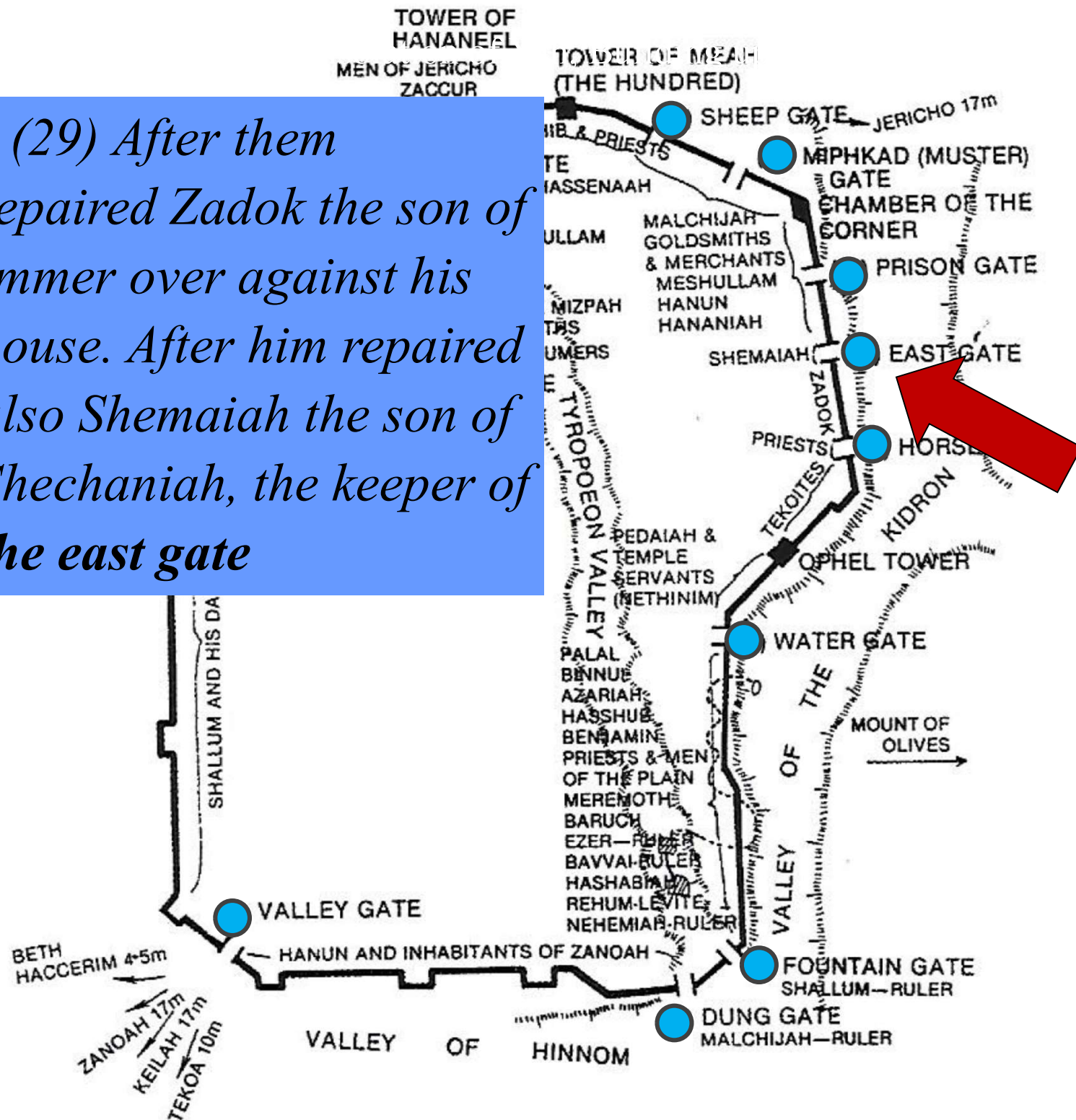

ZECHARIAH 6:1-5

1 And I turned, and lifted up mine eyes, and looked, and, behold, there came four chariots out from between two mountains; and the mountains were mountains of brass. 2 In the first chariot were red horses; and in the second chariot black horses; 3 And in the third chariot white horses; and in the fourth chariot grisled and bay horses. 4 Then I answered and said unto the angel that talked with me, What are these, my lord? 5 And the angel answered and said unto me, These are the four spirits of the heavens, which go forth from standing before the Lord of all the earth.

(29) After them repaired Zadok the son of Immer over against his house. After him repaired also Shemaiah the son of Shechaniah, the keeper of the east gate

Zadok = ***“Just” or “Righteous”***

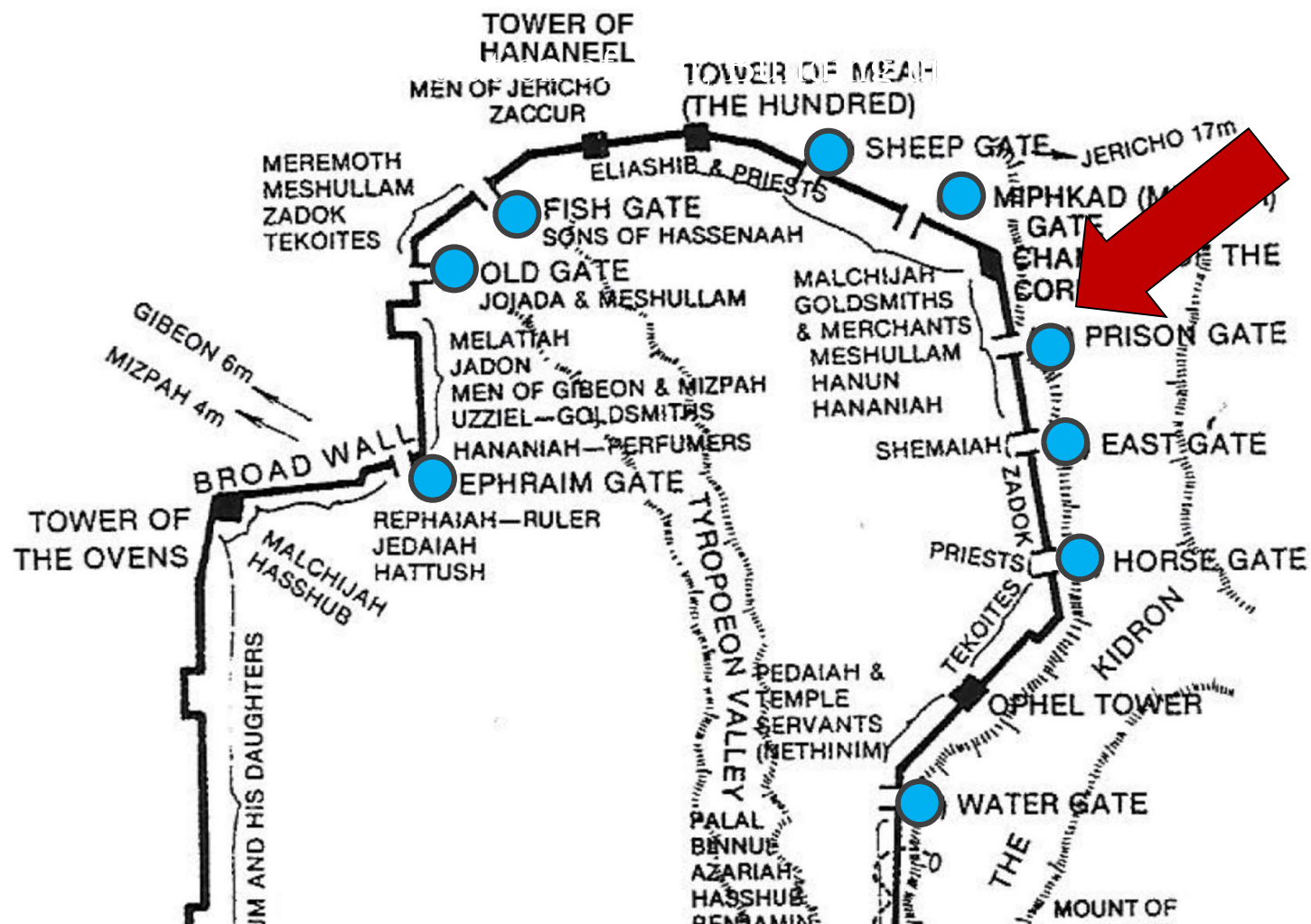
Immer, from a root (amar) = ***“Appoint”***

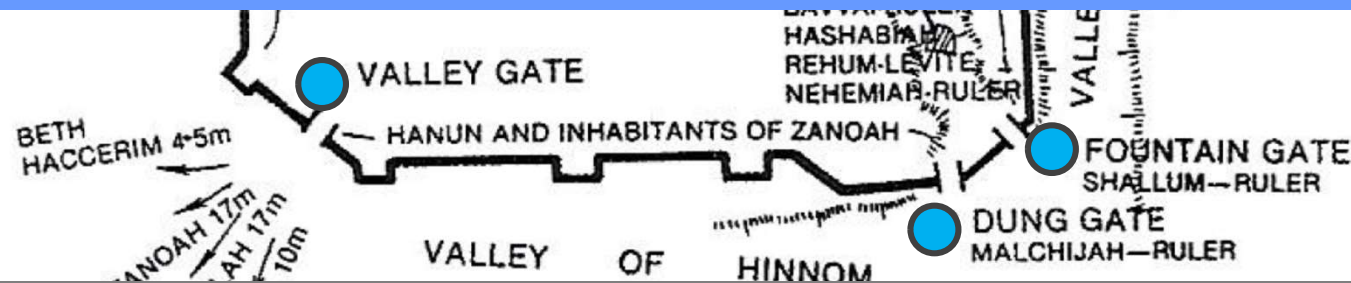
Shemaiah means ***“Yah hath heard”***

Shechaniah means ***“Yah hath Dwelt”***

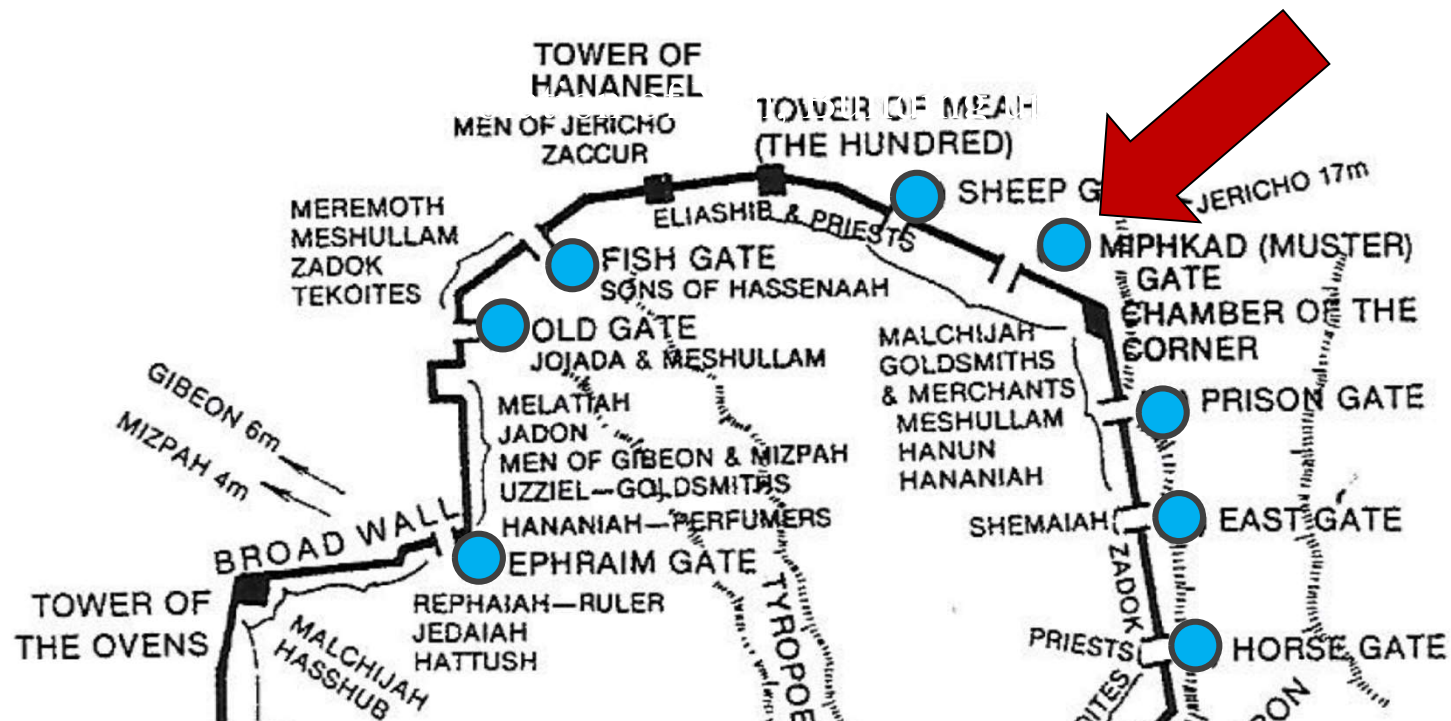
(I Chron 3:22 and Luke 3:26; Jer. 17:25; Luke 1:78-79; Rev. 5:9-10)



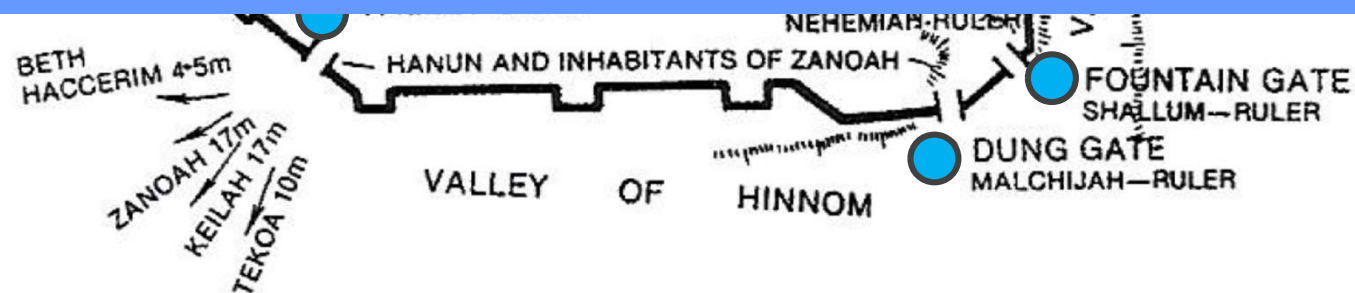
(Isa. 42:6-7; Zech. 9:11; Job 19:25-27; Luke 20:36; I Peter 1:3-4)

*(31) After him repaired Malchiah the goldsmith's son unto the place of the Nethinims, and of the merchants, over against **the gate Miphkad, (Muster or Corner Gate)** and to the going up of the corner. (2 Cor. 5:10; Psa. 50:3-5; Psa. 149:1, 5-9)*

Malchiah, the son of the goldsmith

Malchiah = *King of (appointed by) yah*

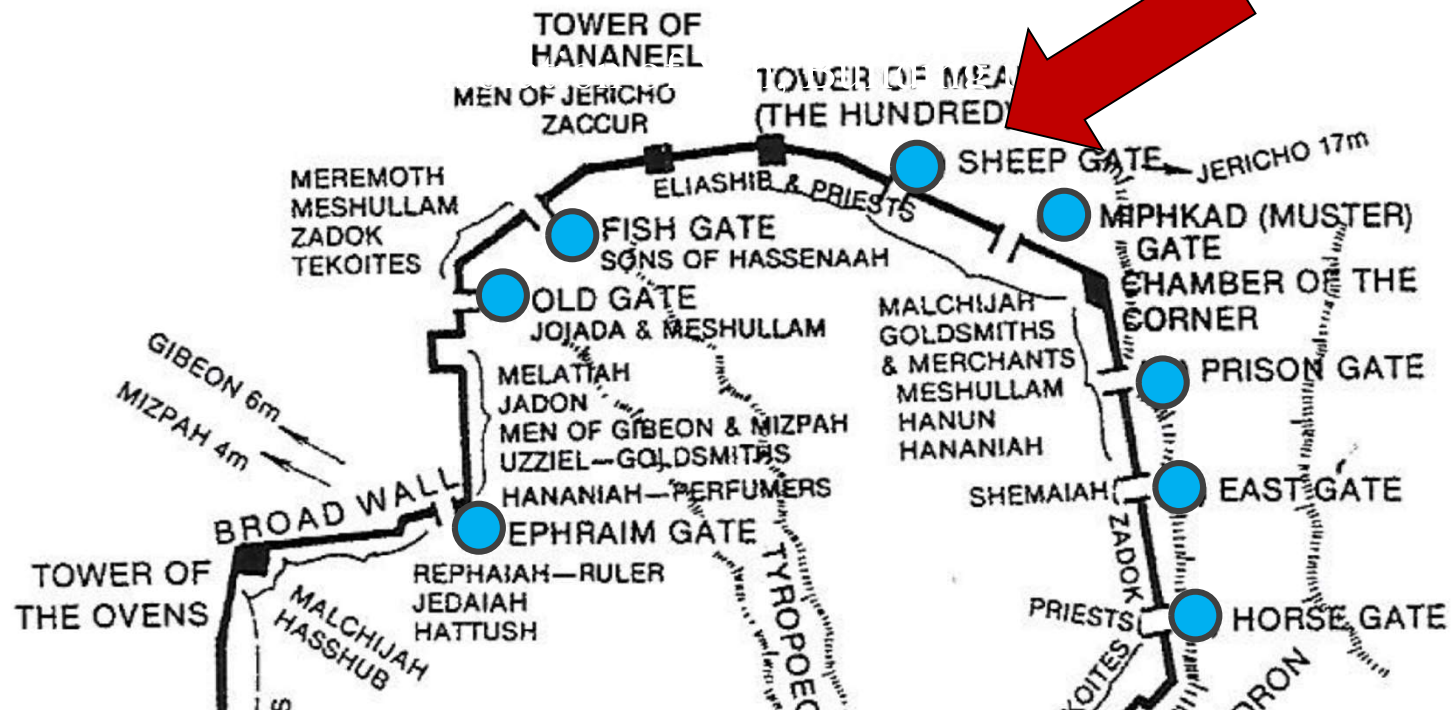
Goldsmith = one who *refines and purges away*

(Psa. 65:3-4; Isa. 1:25-27; Zech 9:9)

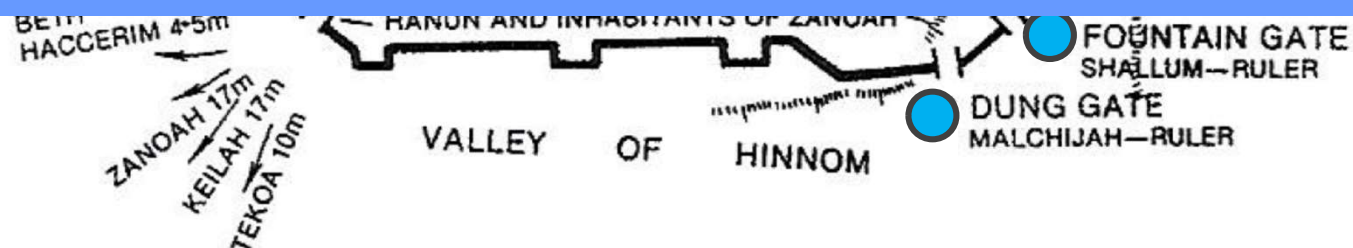
Nethinims = *One Given (Temple Servants)*
(Isa. 11:6, 10)

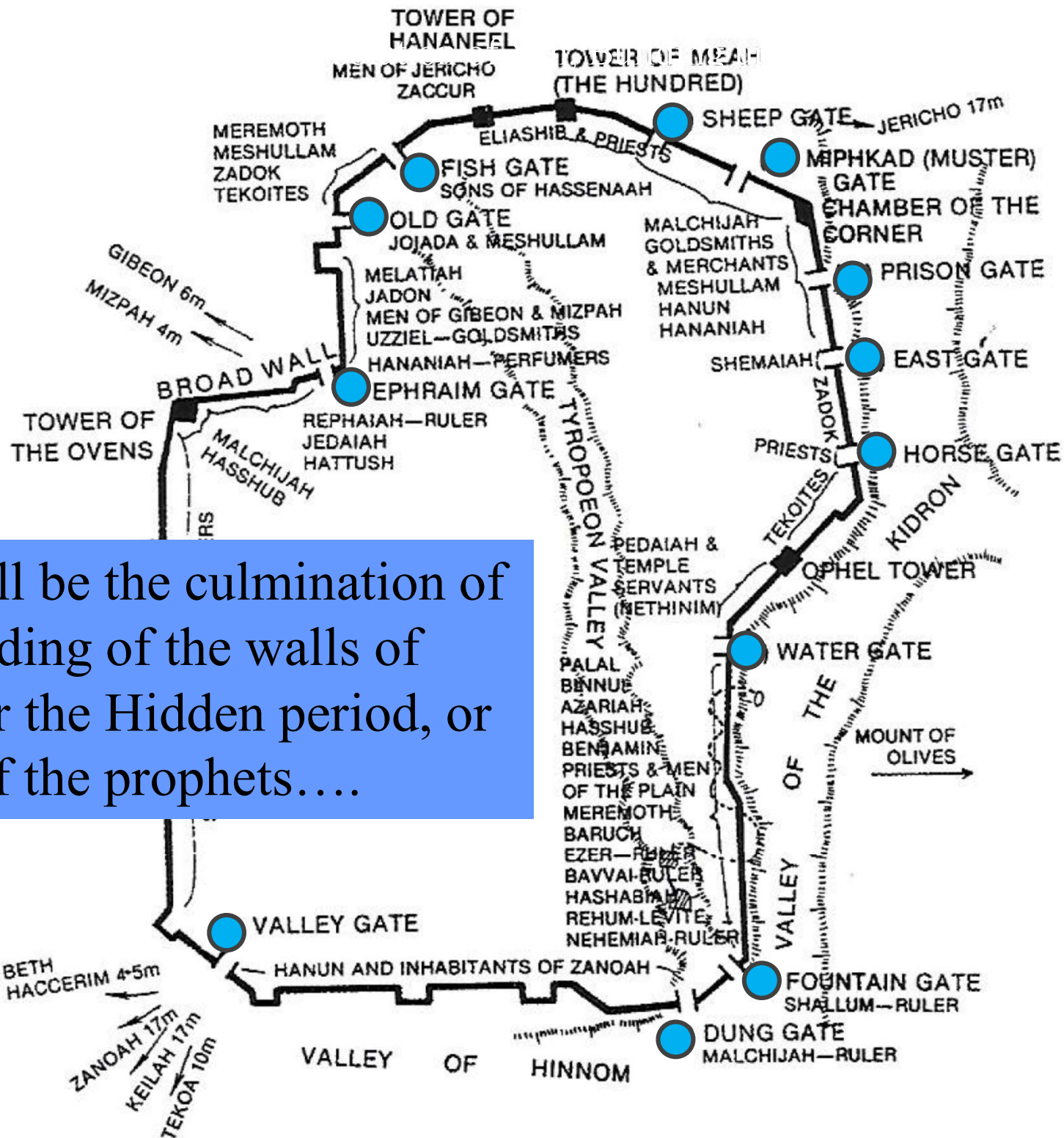
Merchants = Travel, trading (Spice)
merchant **(Song. 4:10-16)**



32) And between the going up of the corner [Gate] unto the sheep gate repaired the goldsmiths and the merchants.
